**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE
VILLAGE MANAGER TO PUT OUT
FOR BID THE PURCHASE OF A FIRE
DEPARTMENT AMBULANCE AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, The Village of Woodlawn has determined that it is necessary to purchase a new fire department ambulance for the Village Fire Department;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Woodlawn, Hamilton County, Ohio, majority of all concurring:

SECTION I That the Village Manager is to hereby take all steps necessary to put out for public bidding the purchase of a Fire Department ambulance with the following specs:

2010 Type III, C4500 166 Wheel Base and 166 Module Length emergency vehicle

SECTION II This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, safety and general welfare for the citizens of the Village of Woodlawn, Ohio, and shall go into effect immediately. The reason for the emergency is the necessity to have this new ambulance to ensure that the public safety needs of the Village of Woodlawn are met as soon as possible.
