**ORDINANCE AMENDING WOODLAWN CODE OF
ORDINANCE'S SECTION 1062.04 (a) REGARDING
THE PROCEDURES FOR PERMITTING
ALCOHOL ON VILLAGE PROPERTY AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, The Village of Woodlawn currently permits users of park and recreation facilities to serve alcohol on municipal property upon the approval of Village Council; and

WHEREAS, The current process is oftentimes not timely for someone wanting to use municipal facilities and because of this, Council desires to pass this responsibility to the Municipal Manager;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Woodlawn, Ohio that

SECTION I. Section 1062.04 (a) of the Woodlawn Code of Ordinances shall be amended to read as follows:

§ 1062.04 (a) No alcoholic beverages are permitted to be served in public parks unless prior approval has been granted by the Municipal Manager. The organization or individual requesting permission must submit the request in writing to the Municipal Manager a minimum of 14 days prior to the date requested. The Municipal Manager's approval of said request shall be based on certain criteria that has been approved by Village Council and as may be amended from time to time by Village Council.

Any applicant denied permission to serve alcohol by the Municipal Manager shall have the right to ask Village Council to reconsider the manager's decision.

SECTION II That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare for the citizens of the Village of Woodlawn, Ohio, and shall go into effect immediately. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to immediately clarify the Village's policies regarding the use of park and recreation facilities.
