**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE
MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
WITH THE HAMILTON COUNTY
DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY
DEVELOPMENT AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village of Woodlawn has been awarded \$215,000 in Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) funds by the Hamilton County Department (HCCD) of Community Development; and

WHEREAS, the HCCD is requiring a signed Memorandum of Understanding to be on file in their office before the funds can be spent by Woodlawn;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Woodlawn, Hamilton County, Ohio:

SECTION I. That the Manager is hereby authorized to execute the Memorandum of Understanding with the Hamilton County Department of Community Development, a copy of which is attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof.

SECTION II. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare; the reason for the emergency being the need to begin and complete spending the allocated dollars within the 18 month timeframe imposed by the federal government, and shall therefore take effect and be in effect immediately upon passage.
