ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY PAPERWORK WITH UNITED HEALTH CARE NECESSARY TO CONTINUE HEALTH CARE COVERAGE FOR FULL TIME EMPLOYEES, CHANGE THE PERCENTAGE SPLIT OF THE COST BETWEEN THE VILLAGE AND THE EMPLOYEES FOR SAID COVERAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Woodlawn, Hamilton County, Ohio, the majority of all members duly elected thereto concurring:

SECTION I: That the Municipal Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute any paperwork with United Health Care that may be necessary to continue health care coverage for full time employees.

SECTION II. That the percentage split between the Village and the employees for the cost of this coverage shall be 75% and 25%, respectively,

SECTION III: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary to the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village, and shall take effect immediately upon its passage. The reason for the emergency is the necessity for Village employees to have adequate, uninterrupted health care coverage at the lowest cost possible to the Village at the soonest possible date.
