**ORDINANCE ELIMINATING HEALTH CARE
INSURANCE OPT-OUT OPTION FOR
EMPLOYEES AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, in 2005 the Village Council approved Ordinance 31-2005 creating a health care insurance opt-out option for employees; and

WHEREAS, it is no longer appropriate or affordable for the Village to continue to provide this option for employees;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Woodlawn, Hamilton County, Ohio, a majority of all members duly elected thereto concurring:

SECTION I The health Care Insurance Opt-out option created for Woodlawn employees pursuant to Ordinance 31-2005 is hereby eliminated and said ordinance repealed.

SECTION II. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary to the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village, and shall take effect immediately upon its passage. The reason for the emergency is the necessity for the Village to save unnecessary expenditures at the soonest possible date.
