**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL
MANAGER TO EXECUTE PAPERWORK WITH
STANDARD INSURANCE FOR LIFE INSURANCE
COVERAGE FOR FULL TIME VILLAGE
EMPLOYEES AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village of Woodlawn desires to continue its life insurance with Standard Insurance Company; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Woodlawn Hamilton County, Ohio, the majority of all members duly elected thereto concurring:

SECTION I: That the Municipal Manager hereby authorized and directed to execute any paperwork necessary with Standard Insurance for continued life insurance coverage for Village employees.

SECTION II: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary to the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village, and shall take effect immediately upon its passage. The reason for the emergency is that it is necessary that Village employees have adequate, continued disability and life insurance coverage.
