**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE
PURCHASE OF ONE POLICE
VEHICLE AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, The Woodlawn Police Department is in need of a new vehicle in order to be able to perform the work that is required of the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Funds adequate to cover the purchase amount for this item was appropriated for 2009;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Woodlawn, Hamilton County, Ohio, and majority of all concurring:

SECTION I The Village Council does authorize the Municipal Manager to purchase one 2010 police vehicle (one patrol car) through the Ohio State Cooperative Purchasing Contract.

SECTION II This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Woodlawn, said emergency being the necessity to have an adequate number of vehicles available for patrolling the Village of Woodlawn and allow for the continuous protection of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Woodlawn. Therefore this ordinance will take effect immediately upon its passage.
