A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE COUNTY
AUDITOR TO MAKE ADVANCE PAYMENTS OF
TAXES PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE
SECTION 321.34

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code allows a taxing authority to request payment from the County Auditor funds derived from taxes or other sources to the County Treasurer, which may be held on account of a local subdivision.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Woodlawn, Hamilton County, Ohio, and a majority of all members duly elected thereto, concurring that:

SECTION I. The Auditor and

the Treasurer of Hamilton County in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 321.34, be requested to draw and pay to the Village of Woodlawn upon written request of Terri Mayle, Finance Director, to the County Auditor, funds due in any settlement of the Village's current fiscal year, from January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009, derived from taxes or other sources, payable to the County Treasurer to the account of the Village of Woodlawn, and lawfully applicable for purposes of the current fiscal year.

SECTION II. The Clerk of the Village of Woodlawn shall forward to the County Auditor a certified copy of this Resolution.
