**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL MANAGER TO
CONTRACT WITH HAMILTON COUNTY FOR THE
SALE OF EXCESS VILLAGE EQUIPMENT THROUGH
HAMILTON COUNTY INTERNET SURPLUS AUCTION AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village of Woodlawn from time to time has surplus equipment that is no longer needed for any public use, is obsolete or unfit for the use for which it was acquired; and

WHEREAS, Hamilton County offers to its municipalities and townships the opportunity to dispose of surplus property through an internet surplus auction in exchange for a 7.5% commission from the sale proceeds of such surplus property; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Woodlawn desires to take advantage of this service in the future to dispose of surplus property;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Woodlawn, Hamilton County, Ohio, the majority of all members duly elected thereto, concurring that:

Section 1. The Municipal Manager shall execute all paperwork necessary to establish the Hamilton County Internet Surplus Auction Site as the primary means of disposing of surplus property identified from time to time by Village Council as no longer needed for any public use, is obsolete or unfit for the use for which it was acquired; and

Section 2. The auction shall be conducted according to the rules established by the Hamilton County Internet Surplus Auction. The number of days for bidding shall be for at least 15 days. Section 3. That Hamilton County shall be compensated 7.5% for any item sold through the Hamilton County Internet Surplus Auction.

Section 4. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary to the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village, and shall take effect immediately upon its passage. The reason for the emergency is the necessity for the Village to collect any revenue possible for the economic health of Woodlawn.
