## GENERAL NEWS

### Administration

1. **Strategic Plan BKA Two Year Action Plan:** On July 27th at 8 am, The Village of Woodlawn will be meeting with Hamilton County Planning and Development and the Woodlawn Community Improvement Corporation to discuss next steps of the Village's Two Year Action Plan. Several meetings have been held with residents and other community constituents to established priorities for the future of the Village of Woodlawn.
2. **Leacrest Rd Update:** Work has begun on Leacrest Rd. by Ford Development Group. Emergency funds have been provided by Hamilton County Municipal Road Fund Program and OPWC Emergency Funds. The total cost will for the Village will be no more than \$15,000.
3. **CiTIRAMA 2017:** The CiTiRAMA Project is going very well in the Village of Woodlawn. Homes are being built as we speak and out of the 43 potential lots, 24 have been pre-sold before the show. The CiTiRAMA Show starts on September 26, 2017. There will be lots of people visiting our community. Let's do our part in making Woodlawn Beautiful!
4. **Beautification Awards:** Thanks to all residents who participated in the Beautification awards. Next year we will be sure to judge all yards in a timely manner. Thanks to all who participated and congratulations!
5. **Village Website is on the Move:** Have you seen the Village's Website? Please go to the website and check out all the latest news on the Village of Woodlawn. The website will be updated a minimum of twice a week, ensuring you are aware of what is going on. Big thanks to Woodlawn's own Ashley Madden and Lauren Flanigan for making our website alive and well!
6. **Have you tried CAGIS:** CAGIS is a property maintenance link on our website. Residents can anonymously report anything from pot holes, high grass as well as loose dogs. Once you register your concern, you will receive an e-mail acknowledging receipt of you your concern and receive another e-mail once the concern has been addressed. It's that easy. If you don't have access to the web, please contact our administrative offices at (513) 771-6130.
7. **Code Red:** Some of you may have noticed a higher number of code Red Messaging going out to all residents. This is our commitment of increasing our transparency to our community constituents. Our goal is to be sure we send out Code Red Messages anytime general programs or events occur in the Village as well as emergencies. If you are not registered to receive Code Red messaging, go to our website or contact the Village's Administrative Offices.
8. **Natural Gas Coming To Woodstock:** Duke Energy has confirmed gas piping will be ran to the Southside of Woodstock Rd. at no cost to the residents. Duke communicated if a minimum of five residents to committed to the use of natural gas they would run the gas lines at no cost to the residents. No word yet when work will begin but we are encouraging more areas in the Village with a desire for Natural Gas contact the Village offices.

## VILLAGE OF WOODLAWN

### Public Works

1. **Duke Street Lighting Update:** The Village of Woodlawn met with Duke Energy to get cost estimate on updating our street lights throughout the Village. The estimated cost for total upgrade of all lights across the Village with the exception of the decorative poles will be determined
2. **Woodlawn Boulevard:** Plans to repair Woodlawn Boulevard and portions of Mayview Forest are underway. Details and time line will follow.
3. **Grant Award:** Woodlawn has received a grant award for waste and recycling. A dumpster will be stationed at the Public Works building for tires. Date for posting TBA.
4. **OPWC Grant Funding Opportunity:** An application training session for Round 32 OPWC funding will take place August 1st, 2017 at 8 am. OPWC has provided "The Package" of documents that they will be reviewing at the session, and which applicants will need when filing their project applications. These documents will be posted on the District's website. A follow up notice will be sent when the documents have been posted.

### Fire:

1. **Fire Prevention and Code Enforcement Bureau:** We are off the ground and moving to make Woodlawn "Beautiful" any concerns or problems please contact the Village Building and they will point you to our website to electronically notify the appropriate personnel to handle any and every concern.
2. **Fire Safety Inspector Class:** The Inspector Class is being held from Sept 26th – December 8th, Woodlawn Employees will be attending for free. The Village of Woodlawn will show a savings of over \$5,000 to include books for conducting the training.
3. **Grant:** The Fire Department received a grant of \$3,700 for EMS equipment, this will help out with our use of Narcan.
4. **Pig Roast Car Show:** The Fire Department is partnering with the Pike Bar and Grill for a PIG ROAST Car Show! All proceeds will help supply the Fire Department with Tactical Bullet proof Vest as well as supporting our community development efforts.
