Dear Fellow Woodlawn Residents;

If you have driven by the corner of Mayview Forest Rd and Woodlawn Blvd (Susan Upton-Farley Way) lately then you've probably seen the sign announcing construction of Harmony Park to happen in spring of 2023. It is exciting to see this project entering its final stages! By the time you read this letter we will have sent plans out for bids from contractors.

Harmony Park will have 8 outdoor musical instruments – more than any other similar music park in the tri-state area. Construction is being financed with a combination of municipal grants, sponsorship from foundations, and contributions from local businesses and residents. This letter is to both inform you of the progress on Harmony Park and give you an opportunity to join the list of donors.

There are opportunities for recognition at various levels. Although many of the instruments have been sponsored, there are still three available to have your name attached to. Another popular options is the engraved paving stones. These engraved pavers will be set in concrete along the Instrument Walkway as a permanent record of your generosity. For a donation of \$250, the large pavers have room for 6 lines of text with 20 characters per line; for a \$100 donation, the smaller pavers have room for 3 lines of text with 20 characters per line.

With the holidays upon us, an engraved paver could be an ideal gift for someone who values our community and doesn't need more "stuff" to dust. Pavers can be bought as memorials to loved ones or to recognize family members, or just to share a favorite quote. And if you act before the end of the year, you may qualify for a tax deduction on your donation – whether it's for a paver or a whole instrument!
