



Funeral Procession for Springdale Officer Kaia Grant

The funeral for fallen Springdale Officer Kaia Grant will be held on Sunday, March 29, 2020. Although funerals are considered exempt from Governor DeWine's "Shelter in Place" order, concessions will be made and we ask that all members of the community practice social distancing.

Beginning at 9am, the police procession will leave Spring Grove Cemetery. The procession will travel up State Route 4 and will pass through Wyoming on the way to its final destination of Vineyard Church in Springdale.

The route of the funeral procession will be:

Spring Grove Cemetery and precede north on RT4/Springfield Pike to Wyoming

Turn right onto Penderly Ave. (pass in front of the Wyoming High School)

Turn left onto Burns Ave.

Turn left onto Chestnut Ave.

Turn right onto Route 4.

Continue north on Springfield Pike to Springdale Police Department

Springdale Police Department proceed Northeast on Lawnview Ave to East on Kemper Rd to South on Century Blvd to the Vineyard Church in Springdale.

The remainder of the service will be held at the Vineyard Church.

10:30am to 11:00am – Private Family Viewing.

11:00am to 12:15pm – Service inside church reserved for family and Springdale Police Personnel.

12:15pm to 1:30pm – Viewing for Springdale Police, Fire, elected officials, and family/friends.

1:30pm to 2:00pm – Ceremonial Honors for Officer Grant on Vineyard property outdoors.

Officers will stand in formation practicing social distancing.

2:00pm – Funeral ends.

The roads will be closed to traffic during the procession so please use both sides of the road to practice responsible social distancing along the route
